(pencil note: See Glasgow Protocol Vol.7, p.35, 36). Referring to pages 5, 12, 16 and 39, I am indebted to Alexander Gray Buchanan for the following information. His letters are deposited in my Deed box. I think we may fairly assume that the first mentioned in the Glasgow Commissary records, James Hogiszaird, was father of the first Robert, from whom our line evidently descends, and all the more, as Robert called his eldest son James according to old Scottish custom. Indeed it appears I think probable that he was the Ancestor of all those mentioned in the commissary records etc., although it is impossible to give a complete statement of their respective relationships. An inspection of dates etc. will shew that he alone of all those mentioned could have been the Common Ancestor of this old and respectable Glasgow family

Revd. Robert Hodgert (Hodgeheard) a minister in Galloway, 3rd Jan. 1673. Graduate (Magister) of the University of Glasgow in the records of which his name, with various spellings, frequently appears (see AGB's letters). There can be little doubt that he was identical with Robert Hogsherd (see marginal note page 5) and must have died before above date.

**BLAIR of that ULK (Red Book p.10).**

★ "The Craigie Arms being impaled with those of Blair in their achievements which are yet to be seen over the main door of the house of Blair (dated 1617)" - Paterson.

William de Blair, mentioned in contracts between Ralph de Eglintoun and town of Irvine, 1205. Said to have died in reign of Alexander II between 1214 and 1249.

William de Blair, styled of that Ulk in charter of Alexander III to the Abbey of Dunfermline about 1260.

Sir Bryce de Blair, who joined Wallace and was taken prisoner by the English and was executed at Ayr, 1296. He left no issue and was succeeded by his brother.

David de Blair, who submitted to Edward I, 1296.

In "Critical remarks on the Ragman's Roll" he is specially mentioned as progenitor of this family.

Roger de Blair, who was a steady adherent of Robert the Bruce and died in the reign of David II.

James, who got a grant of several tenements of land in the vicinity of Ayr which had fallen into the king's hands by forfeiture.

James, who got a charter from Robert II dated 8th May 1375, confirming a charter granted to his father by David II. He died in reign of James I.

John - born c.1630, married May 1668, died 1697 - became a prosperous merchant in Kilmarnock. In 1691 he acquired the "Gleibhouse of Kilmarnock" with garden attached etc., which continued in possession of the family till 1787. He also purchased the lands of Lawhill or Drumgrislaw in Kilmarnock parish and of Waxford (believed to be a corruption of Wallaceford) in Symington parish. Annabella Paterson = The Revd. Robert Findlay D.D. of Waxford and Lawhill - born 22nd when between 4 and 5 years of age - was educated at the Universities of Glasgow & called to be Minister of Stevenston 29th March 1744; of Galston 28th March 1747; of the "North West" Parish of Glasgow 9th December 1755 - appointed Professor he resigned the latter 20th. December 1782 (see pages 8 and 9) - died 15th. June Gleiblands 1787 and Lawhill and (probably) Waxford 1788 (see page 37)

Robert Findlay of Easterhill, born 17th. January 1748 (o.s.); was a merchant in America (see pages 23 and 35) - and afterwards in Glasgow where he attained great eminence. Besides prospering in the extensive business which was carried on with most of the home and foreign and colonial markets, he took a deep interest in everything affecting the advancement of Glasgow and its commerce and was in frequent communication with and largely consulted by the leading Statesmen of the day. He acquired lands of Easterhill 1783 - died 31st. March, 1802.
